RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR SPECIAL ONE-DAY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE APPLICATION

1. Original signed application must be submitted to the Board of Selectmen at least one week prior to the event.
2. Fee in the amount of \$25.00 made payable to the Town of Stockbridge must be submitted with the application.
3. Non-Profit organizations may apply for All Alcohol or Wine and Malt licenses. Proof of non-profit status may be required.
4. Profit enterprises may apply for Wine and Malt license only, unless the event is not-for-profit. Applicants seeking this type of application may be required to submit further information.
5. No special licensee may sell any alcoholic beverage other than those purchased from a licensee under M.G.L. c. 138, §§ 18, 19, 19B, or 19C or from a holder of a special permit to sell issued under M.G.L. c. 138, § 22A. Special licensees **CANNOT** purchase alcoholic beverages from a package store. A list of approved sellers can be found at <http://www.mass.gov/abcc/pdf/authorizedsources1-day.pdf>
6. Special licensees **CANNOT** accept donations of alcoholic beverages unless they have been issued a Charity Wine Fundraising License by the Local Licensing Authority and ABCC
7. No more than one license can be issued for a premises at one time. Therefore, a Section 14 special license cannot be issued for use in a licensed premise. Regulations for Section 14 can be found in 204 CMR 7.00
