

Sewer and Water Minutes

February 6, 2018

Present: Don Schneyer, Tom Schuler, Tony Campetti, and Jennifer Carmichael and Peter Socha; Absent: Mike Buffoni. Don asked for a motion to accept the minutes from January 2nd Tom motioned to approve the minutes.

Both Tony and Mike will level fund their budgets, no meeting with the Finance Committee is necessary. Mike will include the safe water yield article though water surplus will pay for the survey.

Progress on Route 183 Glendale bridge and the Route 183 bridges to the north should start soon. Foresight will not move any sewer lines. The water will need to be moved and a temporary 10" line will be put in. This work will take several months to complete. At the Larrywaug bridge Mike has marked water lines and they have done borings.

The temporary Highway trailer is connected to a 6" sewer line temporarily at the waste water plant. Regarding the new Highway garage: there have been no meetings with Tony and Mike. Mike Kulig put in a bid of \$50,000 to replace the 2" water line. The sewer plant ditches worked well during the cold snap, Tony ran a 1 1/2 inch fire hose at night to keep things moving so there were no freeze ups. There were 4 water line breaks during January, Wilkinson did the 3 residential breaks and Tony and Mark took care of the break at the Interlaken Fire House with the Town excavator.

Tony felt the 8" gravity sewer line would take care of 37 Interlaken Road project. Permittable for sewer is 460,000 gallons per day at the plant. In January the Town did 145,000 gallons per day; peak in the summer is approximately 200,000 gallons per day.

Peter motioned to adjourn the meeting and Tom seconded, all were in favor.
