

STOCKBRIDGE CONSERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES
TUESDAY, 9 January 2018
Town Offices Meeting Room, 7pm, Stockbridge, MA

Present: Ron Brouker [presiding], John Hart, George Shippey, Louise Gachet, Tom LaBelle, Joe DeGiorgis, Jay Rhind, Sally Underwood-Miller

Tom LaBelle made a motion to approve minutes from Tuesday, 12 December 2017 as amended. George Shippey seconded. Motion carried. 8-1-0

Marc Lavasseur of Foresight Land Services and David Potter of Green River Design presented the Notice of Intent for Monte Levin and Gary Lazarus, 1 Grove Road. (Map 104, Lot 105) The proposal is for an addition and site work. The addition will be on helical piers within the current driveway. They propose to start in the spring. Tom Labelle made a motion to accept the proposal and close the hearing. Joe DeGiorgis seconded. Unanimous.

Commissioners need a clarification to issue the Request for Certificate of Compliance for David Shack, 9 Mahkeenac Road. (Map 102, Lot 3. DEP #296-0308) The letter states that work was not completed, but not whether it was never started. The Secretary will contact White Engineering.

Marc Lavasseur also presented the Notice of Intent for Terry Moor, 20 Main Street. (Map 106, lot 64) They plan a conversion of an existing deck to a screened in porch and addition. The property is entirely within the Riverfront and Buffer Zone. Mr. and Mrs. Moor were also present. There will be a disturbance to only .03% in the riverfront. A sight visit is scheduled for Tuesday January 16. The hearing was continued until the next meeting at the request of the applicant.

The Town has a new e-mail system. Everyone will need to set up their new e-mails.

Commissioners still stand against the use of chemicals in the lake, believing that there are many other avenues that must be explored.

Ron Brouker reported that a \$20,000 grant had been received from the state to eradicate the invasive species plants found in Gould Meadows and Bullard Woods. Native Habitat Restoration will do the work. A special account will need to be set up to hold the money until the bills are submitted.

Jay Rhind made a motion to adjourn the hearing at 8:20pm. Ron Brouker seconded. Unanimous.
