

## *Sewer and Water Minutes*

*December 5, 2017*

Present: Don Schneyer, Tom Schuler, Peter Socha, Mike Buffoni, Tony Campetti, and Jennifer Carmichael

Don asked for a motion to approve the minutes from November, Tom motioned to approve and Peter seconded, all were in favor.

Denny Alsop spoke with Don regarding 37 Interlaken Road's aquifer interference. Terri Flynn wants a letter to him about whether an aquifer study should be done. We first need to find out what the project is. There are only preliminary talks; it is too premature to impose a study at this time.

Update on Church Street waterline replacement: 2,375 feet of pipe is in place, They were able to do some blacktop work last week (the end of November). The project is approximately 40% complete and the rest will be done in the spring. They are having to dig 7 ½ to 8 feet down to get below the utilities. The sewer line runs down the road towards the middle of the road. The main electric is on the west side of Church Street. There are now 2 valves for the waterline; many more valves will be added and tested, this will eliminate all the water having to be shut off when there is a problem on the street.

Park Street pump station: the preliminary design is done. They will do a geological drill to determine the makeup of the soil.

Nothing new on the Averic Road closure.

The letter from HCS Civil Environmental Engineering was discussed and Mike will check into the safe yield of water at Lake Averic.

Route 183 Glendale bridge replacement status: There will be a gantry system put in to support the sewer. Temporary 10" plastic pipes will be put in for the water. They will need to get easements from two property owners.

A discussion regarding the protocol for interested parties that come to the meetings to participate and are not on the agenda was had. It was decided that these people would be allowed to present their discussions first and not have to sit through our whole meeting.

There has been no discussion on budgets yet.

Mike spoke with Solitude Lake Management to cut brush at the Pump House and all the water main easements in the wetland areas on Route 183; it has not been done for about 13 years and needs to be.

Tom motioned to adjourn and Peter seconded. Next meeting January 2nd
