

Sewer and Water Minutes

September 5, 2017

Present: Don Schneyer, Tom Schuler, Peter Socha, Mike Buffoni, Tony Campetti and Jennifer Carmichael.

Don asked for a motion to approve the minutes from July; Tom motioned to accept the July minutes and all were in favor.

New Water Tank: The 8" main has been reconnected up near the old Desisto School and across the street. The chlorine byproducts came back high from the last water sample; Mike will drain out about half the tank. The water and chlorine have been sitting so long in the tank with no circulation of the water that Mike needs to get fresh water in the tank to dilute the chlorine. The old tanks will be drained when the new tanks pass the chlorine test. The water from the old tanks will flow out the back road not onto Quiet Knoll Road.

Tony has the preliminary draft plans for the Park Street Pump Station; the engineer wants to put the new pump station where the old one is now.

Church Street water line: the mobilization will start next week, putting in silt fences etc. the asphalt will be cut with the "zipper" down to the concrete. The digging may start the following week; there is a lot of sand and some of the digging will be done by hand around the utilities.

Tom was not able to contact anyone at the old Desisto school, Mike will try to contact the property manager.

Glendale Road bridge/culvert repairs will be done before the bridge in Interlaken. The culvert is collapsing and there is concern that the road will collapse. There is a 10" water main and above that are two sewer lines that run along the road there.

Mike has not heard back from Town Council concerning the public hearing regarding the Averic Road closure.

Tom motioned to adjourn, Peter seconded and all were in favor. The next meeting is October 3rd.
