

STOCKBRIDGE CONSERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES
TUESDAY, 11 April 2017
Town Offices Meeting Room, 7pm, Stockbridge, MA

Present: Ron Brouker [presiding], Joe DeGiorgis, George Shippey, Sally Underwood-Miller.

George Shippey made a motion to approve minutes from Tuesday, 28 March 2017. Joe DeGiorgis seconded. Unanimous.

Kate Fletcher and Ruth Pierce came in to discuss the upcoming proposed revisions to the Zoning Bylaws. They are requesting members of Conservation, ZBA and Historic to help with the draft. Commissioners will decide on the representative. We would like to be copied on the final draft prior to approval, and have regular reports for consideration.

Dana Bixby described the plans for 7 Ice Glen. A Jurisdictional form was approved and sent to the Building Inspector.

The hearing on the Notice of Intent for the Historic New England (Merwin House), 14 Main Street. Map 106, lot 67 was continued until further notice. The proposal is for tree and shrub removal.

Request for Determination of Applicability – Town of Stockbridge Beach. Map 102, Lot 1.
Remove/replace beach sand outside of resource area. (BE)

George Shippey made a motion to approve the plans as presented for the Notice of Intent for Donald Caplin, 16 Lake Drive and close the hearing. Map 104, Lot 17. The plan is to replace existing piers with helical piers and replace some of the block footing. Sarah Gapinski of SK Design represented the Caplins. Joe DeGiorgis seconded. Unanimous.

George Shippey made a motion to accept the Request for Extension DEP #296-0311 for the Stockbridge Bowl weed harvesting. The extension will be for 3 years. Joe DeGiorgis seconded. Unanimous.

George Shippey made a motion to accept the Request for Extension DEP # 296-0324 for routine highway maintenance. Joe DeGiorgis seconded. Unanimous.

Commissioners would like a representative of the Housatonic RR to come in to discuss the YOP.

The Commission received a Closure Report from Entel for the Hydroelectric project's tank.

Joe DeGiorgis made a motion to adjourn at 8:15. George Shippey seconded. Unanimous.
