

**STOCKBRIDGE CONSERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**TUESDAY, 23 May 2017**  
**Town Offices Meeting Room, 7pm, Stockbridge, MA**

Present: Ron Brouker [presiding], Jay Rhind, George Shippey, Joe DeGiorgis, Sally Underwood-Miller.

Jay Rhind made a motion to approve minutes from Tuesday, 9 May 2017. Joe DeGiorgis seconded.

Marc Volk of Foresight Land Services presented the Notice of Intent for Bern Haan, 16 Beachwood Drive. (Map 104, Lot 102) DEP # 296-0457 The project is for the demolition and reconstruction of an existing house and associated sitework. There will be a small addition away from the resource area. There will be a temporary logging bridge to support construction vehicles. They will need to pump water out during construction as the site is within the flood plain. Staked fencing and straw bales will protect the resource area. George Shippey made a motion to accept the project as presented and close the hearing. Joe DeGiorgis seconded. Unanimous.

George Shippey made a motion to continue the hearing on the Notice of Intent for the Town of Stockbridge, South Hill Road. (Map 216, Lot 6) The proposal is to replace a failing existing culvert, and stone headwalls. (BE) Jay Rhind seconded. Unanimous.

Amer Raza presented the Request for Determination of Applicability for Mass DOT, Rte. 102 MM8.1 to the Lee town line. They propose routine resurfacing and cleaning catch basins. Jay Rhind made a motion to accept the proposal and close the hearing. Joe DeGiorgis seconded. Unanimous.

Jay Rhind reported that he had "ridden the rails" on the Housatonic Railroad. One new culvert will need to be marked, but otherwise all is OK.

Sally Underwood-Miller made a motion to reappoint Ron Brouker as Chair. George Shippey seconded. Unanimous.

Jay Rhind made a motion to reappoint John Hart as Vice Chair. Joe DeGiorgis seconded. Unanimous.

Ron and Sally went to look at the work being done on the Mass DOT culvert and drainage system at 62 East Main Street. The work looks OK.

George Shippey made a motion to adjourn the hearing at 7:40pm. Jay Rhind seconded. Unanimous.
