

**STOCKBRIDGE CONSERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**TUESDAY, 28 March 2017**  
**Town Offices Meeting Room, 7pm, Stockbridge, MA**

Present: Ron Brouker [presiding], Bill Briggs, George Shippey, Joe DeGiorgis, John Hart.

George Shippey made a motion to approve minutes from Tuesday, 28 February 2017. Bill Briggs seconded. Unanimous.

Ben Naylor of Berkshire Engineering presented the deed restriction the Commission requested in order to give its final approval of the Request for Determination of Applicability for Anne & Arthur Wichman, 23 Stockbridge Road. Map 205, Lot 73. The proposal was for a deck extension. Since the extension of the deck would place the structure closer to the resource area and given that the Town Bylaw allows for a deck to carry a by-right permission to turn it into a permanent structure, the Commission requested the deed restriction stating that this addition would never become a full structure, and always remain a permeable deck. Having received that deed restriction, George Shippey made a motion to accept the proposal and restriction, and close the hearing. Bill Briggs seconded. Unanimous.

Sarah Gapinski of SK Design presented the Notice of Intent for Donald Caplin, 16 Lake Drive. Map 104, Lot 17. #296-0456 The proposal is to replace existing piers techno-piers or sonotube. Commissioners will do a site visit. Bill Briggs made a motion to continue the hearing. Joe DeGiorgis seconded. Unanimous.

Brent White presented the Request for Determination of Applicability for Chesterwood, 4 Williamsville Road. Map 222, Lot 18. The proposal is for a sewer connection consisting of a 2" low pressure line. Most of the work will be done in the roadway. The roadway will be closed during the work. It has been approved by the Select Board and Water/Sewer. They will be very careful not to disturb the nearby vernal pool. Joe DeGiorgis made a motion to accept the proposal as presented and close the hearing. George Shippey seconded. Unanimous.

John Hart made a motion to approve the Request for Certificate of Compliance for Mass DOT #296-0434. The project was for the closure of the animal dumping ground in the I-90 median. Bill Briggs seconded. Unanimous.

Joe DeGiorgis made a motion to adjourn the hearing at 8:10pm. John Hart seconded. Unanimous.
