

**STOCKBRIDGE CONSERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**TUESDAY, 14 August 2018**

Tom LaBelle made a motion to approve minutes from Tuesday, 24 July 2018. Louise Gachet seconded. Unanimous.

Commissioners welcomed Patrick White as the newest Associate member.

The Request for Certificate of Compliance for Daniel and Carole Burack, 27 Mahkeenac Terrace. (Map 205, Lot 43. DEP # 296-0442, White Engineering) and the Request for Certificate of Compliance for Bernard Haan, 16 Beachwood Drive (Map 104, Lot 102. DEP#296-0457, Creative Building Solutions) were both continued again at the request of the applicants. Both projects were not completed substantially according to plan, and will require further review.

Mark Fadding came in to ask about the procedure for removal of the fencing and brush on the property just south of the causeway. The issue of ownership must be established, and more detail regarding what exactly is proposed must be submitted. Any brush removal will require a filing.

Discussion ensued regarding the anticipated application for the use of aquatic weedkiller in the Lake. Commissioners have several questions regarding the standing of the SBA to submit the application over the opposition of the Board of Selectmen. Commissioners have several questions that need to be posed to Town Counsel. Tom LaBelle will assemble a preliminary list for the Chairman to send, subject to review by other Commissioners.

Patrick White asked what protections there are for the 22 acre parcel on Lily Pond. Tom LaBelle explained the inherent restrictions in the deed under MGL 40 8c.

John Hart made a motion to adjourn the hearing at 8:35. Tom LaBelle seconded. Unanimous.
