

Sewer and Water Minutes

September 18, 2018

Present: Don Schneyer, Peter Socha, Tony Campetti, Mike Buffoni and Jennifer Carmichael, absent Tom Schuler. Don asked for a motion to accept the minutes from July, Peter motioned to approve the minutes, all were in favor.

Abatement was given to 3 Train Hill Road for the sewer; the leaking hose went into the ground and not the sewer. There was also abatement given for 106 East Main St from Town of Lee to Stockbridge.

Church St and Yale Ct. water line replacement: pipes ready to go in at Yale Ct. for 8" watermain; five houses will connect. The hydrant will be put in at the end of the street.

There have been no signs of beaver activity at the lake or feeder streams, samples will be taken this week.

The water plant water pump is rebuilt and has been re-installed. All the pumps are old and money should be set aside for high lift pump #2 as the repair will run \$24,000 – \$26,000.

Glendale culvert: the new water main is in and they are now working with the installation of the sewer lines.

Town shed demolition will be done by Associated Building Wreckers, they will come Tuesday to start remediation and then demo.

Elm Street hydrant: cost for parts was \$1,500, Mike replaced it immediately.

Route 102: 10-inch insta-valve for the water main was stuck shut. The 12-inch main on Route 183 works. The Rte. 102 valve is 20 years old cost \$10,000. Don and Peter suggested putting money aside to get new valves. Mike mentioned the 3 valves at the end of North Church and one at the end of Church St that are being dug up might be used for the Route 102 valve. The water line for Train Hill will be done in the spring.

The excavator has a new brush hog attachment to cut brush.

Peter motioned to adjourn the meeting and all were in favor.
