Last Meeting Minutes – Last meeting minutes were reviewed and accepted as written.

BCAA Fall Meeting – Mike informed the Board that the meeting this year is Thursday October 18th, 8:30 a.m. at Mazzeo's Restaurant in Pittsfield, MA.
