

Sewer and Water Minutes

Present: Don Schneyer, Peter Socha, Tony Campetti, Mike Buffoni and Jennifer Carmichael, absent Tom Schuler. Don asked for a motion to accept the minutes from September, Peter motioned to approve the minutes, all were in favor.

Yale Court: The water main is in and the hydrant was installed on Friday September 30. It needs to be charged and flushed, then chlorinated and flushed then hookup and connect to homes. The road will be patched in the spring.

There was no real problem with the Glendale culvert, the hose used to pump water out had a hole where muddy water was spraying out, it is still being worked on.

Train Hill sewer line: discussion if residents wanted to donate sewer line to Town; having this utility increases the value of the home. Property owners paid to have sewer line put in about 2006, what is it worth. The sewer line involves four homes on Train Hill Road.

Tony has been talking with the state regarding the water on the road at the intersection of Route 7 and Route 102. Tony sent a sample of the water to be tested; if the test comes back clean the state will dig in the road. It is not from the water project that was done six years ago.

Mike has started writing the OEM manual for the state.

Peter motioned to adjourn the meeting and all were in favor.
