

**Town of Stockbridge Historic Preservation Commission**  
**Minutes of Meeting**  
**October 7, 2019**

The Town of Stockbridge Historic Preservation Commission held a public meeting at the Town Offices on Monday, October 7, 2019, beginning at 4:00 PM. Present from the Commission were Gary Johnston, Jorja Marsden, Jay Rhind, Pam Sandler and Secretary Peter Williams. In Chairman Sprague's absence, Mr. Williams presided over the meeting. **Minutes**

The Commission unanimously approved the draft minutes of its meeting of August 19, 2019.

**23 Hawthorne Street**

The Commission next considered and heard an Application for Alteration (“the Application”) with respect to the house at 23 Hawthorne Street (“the House”) owned by Club Mess, LLC. The Application was presented by attorney for the owner, Nicholas Arienti. The Commission reviewed the proposed alterations to the House, which were described in plans and elevations attached to the Application as Exhibit D (collectively the “Plans”). Following the presentation and discussion, the Commission unanimously determined that the House is not a “Significant Historic Building” as defined in Section 2.6 of Article XXII of the Town Bylaws.
